

DIRECTIONS— WINTER 2019

Meet at 10AM at trailhead unless noted otherwise. Hikes conclude by 3PM. Distances approximate — check local maps. Hikes are ranked 1, 2, or 3, from easiest to more challenging in terms of length, elevation &/or terrain.

LOWER STEVENS CREEK COUNTY PARK, 2

From Hwy 280 in Cupertino, take Foothill Blvd S, which becomes Stevens Canyon Road, & continue beyond the reservoir. Meet in the Cooley Picnic Area on the RT, just S of Mt. Eden Rd. Shuttle to nearby trailhead.

PESCADERO STATE BEACH & MARSH—bring binoculars, 1

Take Hwy 84 W (or Hwy 92) to Hwy 1 on the coast. Turn LF and continue S towards Pescadero. Meet in the northernmost paved parking area (N of Pescadero Road), at the base of the hill across from the N Pond, near the restroom.

SAM MCDONALD COUNTY PARK, 2

Take Hwy 84 to La Honda. Just W of town, turn LF onto Alpine/Pescadero Rd. for about 1 mile. Turn RT at the fork, following Pescadero Rd. uphill for another mile or so. Turn RT into park entrance. Shuttle up to trailhead.

SKYLINE RIDGE OPEN SPACE PRESERVE, 2

Park in the dirt lot for **Russian Ridge** (adjacent to Skyline Ridge), on the NW corner of the intersection of Hwy 35 / Skyline & Page Mill Road above Palo Alto, across the road from Alpine Pond.

WILDER RANCH STATE PARK, 1

Take Hwy 17 to Santa Cruz. Exit N on Hwy 1/Mission St. and drive N through town. About 2 miles N of the last stop light, turn LF into Wilder Ranch. Meet near restrooms.

WUNDERLICH COUNTY PARK—main entrance, 2

From Hwy 280 in Woodside, take the Woodside/Hwy 84 exit W. After passing through the village, watch carefully for a narrow entrance to the park on the RT. (If 84 branches off to the RT, you've missed it—try again).
